Tick what your child is doing now. "Expected by" is the age by which **most** children do each thing, not an average, so there's a wide range of normal before it. If your child was born more than three weeks early, use their corrected age.

When to ask for advice

A "not yet" isn't a problem on its own, especially if your child hasn't reached the age given. If something marked **worth checking promptly** isn't happening by that age, or your child has stopped doing something they could do before, speak to your health visitor or GP. For anything else that worries you, try our free online checker or get in touch.

This checklist is general information, not an assessment of your child. "Expected by" ages are drawn from conservative, published norms (NHS, WHO and CDC developmental guidance). It does not replace an assessment.
